

English Summer Courses at City College Coventry

25th June - 17th August 2012



City College Coventry is a vibrant, well equipped college with a history dating back to 1828. We have a strong international reputation and currently welcome students from over 25 countries.

Situated in the heart of England close to Shakespeare country we are just 20 minutes by train from Birmingham, Britain's second city, and 1 hour by train to London. Famous for its cathedral, car manufacturing and engineering, Coventry is a friendly and cosmopolitan city with a population of around 300,000.

We have been running our popular **English Summer Course** for over 20 years. The programme provides 15 hours of classroom tuition each week (3 hours every morning Monday to Friday) plus tutorials and runs at a minimum of 2 levels from Pre-Intermediate level and above (not suitable for absolute beginners).

To maximise your time with us we also offer a 21 hour per week study option which allows you to join workshops two afternoons per week to improve your English language skills.

There is also a full programme of social activities, many of which are free, as well as half-day and full day excursions. Some of the places you may visit are Oxford, London and Stratford-upon-Avon. We suggest you allow £15 - £25 per week for these social activities. These trips and excursions are an excellent way for you to experience British culture and also to meet students from different countries and cultures in a relaxed and fun environment.



Tuition Fees: General English £160 per week (15 hour course). General English and Workshops £210 per week (21 hour course).

Start dates: 25th June, 9th July, 23rd July, 6th August (minimum enrolment 2 weeks)

Accommodation: We can provide home stay accommodation either half-board (bed, breakfast and evening meal with lunches at weekends) or self-catering (you buy your own food and use the host family kitchen and equipment).

Accommodation fees: Half-board £110 per week. Self-catering £80 per week.

How to apply: Please complete the application form overleaf using block capitals and black ink and send it to us with your tuition deposit of £320 plus 2 weeks accommodation deposit if you request us to arrange this for you.
